

**NPC-PERAK 'WORLD OF WONDERS' TREASURE HUNT 2017
(KL – PANGKOR)
16-17 SEPT 2017**



RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Introduction

The **NPC-PERAK 'WORLD OF WONDERS' TREASURE HUNT 2017** will be organised in two categories – Media (for NPC members in benefit and people from the media and media-related disciplines) and Open (for the general public). The hunt will run from Kuala Lumpur to Lumut on Saturday 16 September 2017, and all participants will then board the ferry to Pangkor.

2. Slogan & Objectives

The theme for the event is “Perak World of Wonders”. While promoting tourism, the hunt will also help to:

- a. promote cooperation among the participants.
- b. foster the spirit of goodwill.
- c. foster the spirit of camaraderie.
- d. facilitate acquisition of knowledge and information.
- e. encourage critical thinking.
- f. promote safe driving.
- g. create fun and fellowship in a civil society.

3. Participation & Entry Fee

Participation is open to two, three or four persons per vehicle. The entry fee is dependent on the room type, as follows:

- i. Standard /Superior Room (Twin-sharing):
Deluxe Room (Triple sharing)
RM200 per pax for Media Category
RM220 per pax for Open Category
- ii. Chalet -Garden Villa (1 Queen bed and 1 Single bed/2 Single beds – for two or three pax)

RM250 per pax for Media Category
RM270 per pax for Open Category
- iii. Chalet -Bayu Villa (1 Queen bed and 1 Single bed /2 Single beds – for two or three pax)

RM250 per pax for Media Category
RM270 per pax for Open Category
- iv. Chalet -Family Villa (two rooms for four pax).

RM270 per pax for Media Category
RM290 per pax for Open Category

The entry fee entitles each participant to, among other things, a one-night accommodation (triple-sharing or twin-sharing basis) at Puteri Bayu Beach Resort in Pangkor, one breakfast, one dinner, return ferry fare (Lumut-Pangkor), jetty-hotel transfer and parking for one vehicle at Lumut for one night. Allocation of the hotel rooms will be on a first-come first-served basis upon payment of the entry fees in full.

Prior booking is not allowed. The NPC members in benefit will receive a rebate of RM20.00 per member from the rate for the Media Category.

4. Submission of Entry Forms

The entry form is available at the National Press Club, 84, Jalan Tangsi, 50480 Kuala Lumpur. Online registration and downloadable forms are available at the NPC website: www.nationalpressclub.org.my/treasurehunt.

Completed forms must be submitted, together with the entry fee, to the NPC or faxed to **03 – 2691 6331** along with the bank-in slip (with the participants' names) as proof of payment of entry fee to Maybank Account No. **564258-410498**. Cheques must be made out in the name of **"The National Press Club Malaysia (1992)"**. The closing date for submission of the entry form is **Monday 4 September 2017**.

5. Collection of Goodies & Briefing

The goodie bags can be collected at Wisma BERNAMA off Jalan Tun Razak from 6 pm on Thursday 14 September 2017. The briefing will also be held at the same venue on the same date.

7. Venue of Start and Finish

The hunt will be flagged off at Wisma Bernama, off Jalan Tun Razak, Kuala Lumpur on Saturday 16 September 2017 and end at Lumut, Perak. Participants will be informed of the time of flag-off at the briefing on Thursday 14 September 2017.

8. Prizes

Tentatively, the following prizes will be awarded:

First:	RM5,000.00 cash per team
Second:	RM3,000.00 cash per team
Third:	RM2,000.00 cash per team
Fourth:	RM1,000.00 cash per team
Fifth:	RM 800.00 cash per team
Sixth:	RM 600.00 cash per team
Seventh:	RM 500.00 cash per team
Eighth:	RM 400.00 cash per team
Ninth:	RM 300.00 cash per team
Tenth:	RM 200.00 cash per team
Eleventh – Twentieth	RM 100.00 cash per team

Teams in the two categories – Media and Open – will vie for the same prizes. However, bonus prizes of RM1,000.00, RM800.00, RM600.00, RM500.00 and RM400.00 will be given to the top five teams in the Media Category according to their placing from the fourth position downwards. The bonus prizes will not be given to teams from the Media Category that win the top three prizes.

9. Eligibility of Vehicles

All participating vehicles must be in compliance with the Road Transport Act and eligible for use on public roads. Vehicles entered for this hunt cannot carry any trade plate. Participants must have adequate knowledge of their vehicles and should be able to present the vehicles for an inspection, if necessary, before the start of the event.

It is recommended that the vehicles be equipped with a speedometer with reading in kilometres and a trip meter (which is a standard feature in all vehicles). It is also recommended that participants bring along safety gadgets such as a vehicle fire extinguisher, a first-aid box and so on.

10. Insurance and Indemnity

The organiser and sponsors cannot be held responsible for any accident that the participants or vehicles may be involved in during the event, or for violation of traffic rules and regulations by the participants.

Participants are fully responsible for the safety of themselves and their families or relatives and friends, and cannot make any claims against the organiser, sponsors or other officers.

Drivers must be in possession of a valid insurance policy that covers them against third-party liability. **Drivers, navigators and passengers must sign the indemnity form attached to the entry form.**

11. The Rights of the Organiser

The organiser retains the right to:

- a. reject any entry.
- b. cancel or postpone the hunt, without notice, should there be less than 30 entries or for unavoidable reasons. Any claim arising out of the cancellation or postponement will not be entertained.
- c. deny participation of any person or vehicle after inspection shows their ineligibility.
- d. deny participation of any person felt to be unsuitable for participation for health reasons, deformity or instability due to being under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- e. dismiss any participant who brings along additional passengers whose names have not been entered in the entry form.

12. Caution

The **NPC-PERAK 'WORLD OF WONDERS' TREASURE HUNT 2017** is not a race and, as such, speed will not contribute towards winning. A speeding offence may result in penalty points and disqualification.

13. Interpretation of Rules

The organiser and clerk-of-course of the hunt reserve the right to determine any matter not stated in the rules and regulations.
